

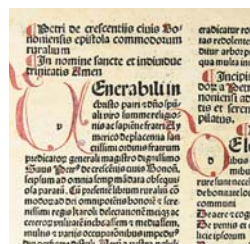

The International Library “La Vigna” (vineyard) is specialized in documentation and research in the field of agriculture and various topics of traditional farm culture.

About 50,000 volumes, dating from the XV century to the present, are utilized for research by universities and scholars alike. Some books are available on-line, which have been adopted by patrons (click on “Adotta un libro”).

“La Vigna News”, an on-line magazine, is published every three months (click on “the centre” and then “bulletins”).

Demetrio Zaccaria (1912 – 1993), the library's founder, started his collection in the '50s. In 1981, he donated his library and the building “Palazzo Brusarosco-Zaccaria” to Vicenza. Since then, important collections have been acquired.

The building is also famous for the “Gallo Apartment”. Ettore Gallo contracted the architect Carlo Scarpa to renovate the building (1962 – 1965). The second floor apartment is often used for exhibitions. The main floor hall hosts diverse events such as conferences, book presentations,



or research projects, and is home to several Italian associations:
